



## ON-STREET PARKING GUIDELINES FOR MOBILE FOOD VENDORS IN THE CITY OF URBANA

Urbana has a long-standing history of encouraging and promoting business, including the proliferation of mobile food vendors. Residents and visitors alike have frequented mobile food vendors in various Urbana locations for many years. With the recent rise in popularity, mobile food vendors are becoming more main stream and the push to gather information on how and where to operate has increased. Therefore, the following information will be applicable to all mobile food vendor requests for on-street metered parking reservations.

Mobile Food Vendors shall not:

- Utilize short term parking spaces as defined by 2 hour duration or less
- Obstruct visibility of a pedestrian crosswalk
- Encroach into or obstruct a bike lane
- Be located directly in front of an existing business or store front
- Be located adjacent to a busy intersection and add to vehicle and pedestrian congestion
- Contribute to any other traffic lane encroachment or visibility obstruction the City deems unsafe

City staff will address requests on a first come, first served basis and reserves the right to cancel meter bag agreements at any time. If two meter heads are on one post at a given location, both meters must be bagged and paid for. If you have any questions, please contact the Finance Department at (217) 384-2346. Thank you.

City staff will address requests on a first come, first served basis and reserves the right to cancel meter bag agreements at any time.
