The Public and the Minority driving population are encouraged to attend this town hall meeting to share their stories about how traffic stops have impacted them.

The City of Urbana I.D.O.T. Traffic Stop Data Task Force has been charged since June 18, 2014 with identifying and studying any racial disparities that may exist in local traffic stop data supplied annually to the City by the Illinois Department of Transportation (I.D.O.T.), and attempting to find the source and cause of any disparity. The Task Force is examining multiple aspects of the traffic stop data, including how traffic stops have an impact on drivers' daily lives.
