- > 89 Solidarity Gardens volunteer and approximately 400 plants and seeds were distributed
- Covid Fund updates
- Angel Donor Fund
- Permanent Housing for Homeless Residents

Ms. Chynoweth addressed question from trustees about charges to the credit card account and rental assistance program.

Township Assessor Wayne Williams reported that all property assessments have been submitted to the county.
