C. Resolution No. 2012-07-053R: A Resolution Certifying a Community
Housing Development Organization for the Urbana HOME Consortium for FY
2012-2013 (Ecological Construction Laboratory, LLC)

Jennifer Gonzalez (Grants Coordinator) gave the staff report. This resolution certifies the Ecological Construction Laboratory, LLC (Eco Lab) as a Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO) for the Urbana HOME Consortium for the fiscal year of 2012-2013. The certification is required to pursue the lease purchase amendment of the proposed Ordinance No. 2012-07-079. Discussion followed.

Alderman Smyth made a motion to consider this item as it had not been sent through Committee first. Alderman Bowersox-Johnson seconded and the motion carried by a voice vote.

D. Ordinance No. 2012-07-079: An Ordinance Approving a Third Amendment to an Urbana HOME Consortium Community Housing Development Organization Developer Agreement (Ecological Construction Laboratory - Super Energy Efficient Home, FY 2007-2008)

Jennifer Gonzalez (Grants Coordinator) gave the staff report. The original contract to construct at 1302 W. Dublin was signed on July 27, 2007 with stipulated completion date of July 27, 2012. It became evident the unit could be not completed by the means of a traditional sale and staff began working with David Young of the Housing Action Illinois who was referred and contracted by Department of Housing and Urbana Development (HUD) to provide technical assistance to the City. HUD has agreed to allow the project to be converted to a lease purchase project and a suitable buyer has been found. The buyer will move in October 1, 2012 and she will continue to receive homebuyer counseling. The unit will be sold for \$114,500 which is the appraised value and the down payment assistance of \$39,999 will help with financing for maximum loan amount of \$74,501. Discussion followed.
