III. Ordinance No. 2020-10-052: An Ordinance Settling Dispute over Post-Judgment Interest due on the Carle Foundation Litigation

City Attorney James Simon presented this item with the recommendation for approval. He said that in January 2020 following a lengthy trial, the court entered judgment in favor of the Carle Foundation. The County tendered to Carle the post-judgment interest it believed was due and owed to them. However, a dispute arose between the City and the County that involved in part which post-judgment interest statute to apply and the fact that Urbana submitted the required amount in time. Instead of litigating the dispute, City staff recommends accepting the reduced amount proposed by the County.

Mayor Marlin added that the original amount was \$ 19,539.08 and the settlement amount was reduced to \$10,749.49.

After presentation and brief discussion, CM Colbrook made a motion to approve Ordinance No. 2020-10-052 as presented. Seconded by CM Wu and carried by roll call vote as follows:
