The City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, met in Special session October 8, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at the Urbana City Building.

IV. **Resolution No. 2018-10-046R**: A Resolution Approving a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Council 31, Local 1331 (Term of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2021)

Mayor Marlin introduced Resolution 2018-10-046R. CM Ammons moved approval of Resolution 2018-10-064R, seconded by CM Roberts. Mayor Marlin thanked all involved in bringing the agreement to fruition noting the hard work involved. With no further discussion, the motion passed 7-0 by roll call: Ammons – Aye; Brown – Aye; Hazen – Aye; Jakobsson – Aye; Miller – Aye; Roberts – Aye; Wu – Aye.

V. **Ordinance No. 2018-10-064**: An Ordinance Revising the Annual Budget Ordinance (Budget Amendment #4 – AFSCME Labor Agreement)

Mayor Marlin introduced Ordinance 2018-10-064. CM Roberts moved approval of Ordinance 2018-10-064, seconded by CM Ammons. The motion passed 8-0 by roll call: Ammons – Aye; Brown – Aye; Hazen – Aye; Jakobsson – Aye; Miller – Aye; Roberts – Aye; Wu – Aye; Mayor Marlin – Aye.

VI. Mayoral Appointments to Boards and Commissions

- 1. Sustainability Advisory Commission Vice Chair term to end June 30, 2020
 - a. Andrew Stumpf

Mayor Marlin nominated Andrew Stumpf, a current member of the Sustainability Advisory Commission, to the position of Vice Chair. Motion to approve the appointment was made by CM Jakobsson, seconded by CM Ammons, and passed by unanimous voice vote.

VII. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, Mayor Marlin adjourned the meeting at 6:54 p.m.
