RE: An Ordinance Amending Schedule H of Section 23-93 of the Urbana Local Traffic Code Requiring Stop Signs at a Certain Intersection (Cyprus Pointe at Stillwater Landing)

Attached is an ordinance for your approval from action taken by the Urbana Traffic Commission at its October 9, 2019 meeting.

The ordinance (Schedule H) is for the installation of a stop sign for northbound traffic on Cyprus Pointe at Stillwater Landing. Section 2B.04 of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices established the criteria for the installation of stop signs. More specifically, the criteria for the installation of a stop sign on a minor street states that a stop sign may be installed if one or more of the following conditions exists:

- A. An intersection of a less important road with a main road where application of the normal right-of-way rule would not be expected to provide reasonable compliance with the law;
- B. A street entering a designated through highway or street; and/or
- C. An unsignalized intersection in signalized area.

Stillwater Landing is the main road entering the intersection. Traffic on Stillwater Landing would expect traffic on Cyprus Pointe to stop, but currently there is no stop sign on Cyprus Pointe. The conditions for installing a stop sign are met for letter A of the above for Cyprus Pointe at Stillwater Landing.

The Traffic Commission considered this location at its October 2019 meeting and recommends that the ordinance be passed by the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-10-056

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE H OF SECTION 23-93 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE REQUIRING STOP SIGNS AT A CERTAIN INTERSECTION

(Cyprus Pointe at Stillwater Landing)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,

as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule H of Section 23-93, entitled "Stop Signs Pursuant to Section 23-93", of Article VIII of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by ADDING to that schedule the following intersections where drivers of vehicles shall be required to stop before entering the intersections:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Direction</u>	<u>Street</u>
Cyprus Pointe	Northbound	Stillwater Landing

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.


