SUBJECT: 2013 Annual Report, Building Safety Division

The following report describes the Building Safety Division activity for the year January 1 through December 31, 2013. This information is presented in terms of number of permits, number of inspections, and revenue generated by permit type. Revenue from the eighth year of the rental registration program is included, in addition to time series information over the five-year period beginning in 2009. A report on activities of the housing inspection section is also included.

Building Permits and Activities. The total number of permit related inspections performed by the division in 2013 was 2,208, which is 440 fewer than last year's inspection total of 2,648. The average total number of annual inspections over the last five year period was 2,658.

The number of new single family residence permits issued decreased by about 33%, from 23 in 2012 to 15 in 2013. The five year average of new single family residence permits is 25 (2009-2013). The total number of permits issued by the division in 2013 was 1,318, which is a decrease from the 1,499 permits issued in 2012. Over the last five years, the annual average number of all permits issued was 1,533.

Significant projects completed during 2013 include the Carle HVI wing, the Crystal Lake Aquatic Center, co-lab at 206 West Main, Mervis Industries Recycling Center, Attie's Bar and Grille in Stone Creek, Dollar Tree General Store, Fira Boutique in Gregory Place, an addition to Creative Thermal Solutions, and multi-family projects at 3034 Stillwater Landing and Hamilton on the Park.

Projects in 2013 that continued into 2014 include the Birkey's Farm Store, Carle Emergency Room expansion and addition, Carle 6th floor oncology renovation, Wendy's Restaurant, Fusion and Café Bene in Gregory Place and multifamily projects at Eastland Apartments, Stillwater Landing, and Clark Lindsey Villas. Construction is expected to begin this year on multi-family projects at Stillwater Landing and Campus Circle Apartments, the remodeling of 1406 Cardinal Road for Illinois American Water, and the addition of a dust collection system at Guardian West.

Revenue Summary. The total Building Safety revenue from all sources (plan review, permit fees, rental registration fees) in 2013 was \$ 692,471. This amount is 18.6% more than the 2012 revenue of \$583,776.

Revenue from rental registration totaled \$276,392 (including late fees and, fines), which was a 37% increase from the 2012 total of \$201,687. This revenue increase is partially a result of the change in rental registration fees approved by the City Council in October 2013. In addition, the Division collected a total of \$7,300 in fines for Failure to Comply tickets.

Over the most recent five-year period, the Building Safety Division has collected a total of \$3,350,308 in all fees with an average of \$670,061 annually.

Housing Activity. The Building Safety Division added a Code Enforcement Coordinator in April, 2013 to increase the effectiveness of housing inspection activities and to work with Legal Division staff in addressing problem property issues. The Building Safety Division, working in conjunction with the Finance Department and Accounting Division, processed the eighth billing for Urbana's Rental Registration Program. In 2013, initial systematic inspections of 1,012 multi-family dwelling units and 184 single and duplex dwelling units were completed. In addition, 2,228 follow-up inspection visits were necessary to ensure full compliance, resulting in 3,424 (initial and follow-up) inspections for 2013.

A total of 50 tenant complaints were received by the Building Safety Division resulting in 166 inspections (initial and follow-up to ensure compliance). The majority of these violations were corrected within 30 days.

The service contract with the University of Illinois for the City to complete Certified Housing inspections was renewed in 2013. Building Safety staff conducted annual inspections of 24 buildings housing a total of 1,321 student residents. Nineteen buildings were cleared of all violations within the initial reinspection time frame, two within 53 days and one within 78 days. The remaining two buildings received extensions to allow for the remaining maintenance corrections to be completed over the December holiday break.

Other Division Activities. As part of an ongoing interdepartmental effort, staff continues to work on the Problem Property Team with Police, Fire, Public Works, Legal and the Mayor to address problem properties in the City. The team meets weekly to keep informed and strategize on mitigating these problems. Housing inspectors also regularly monitor problem properties until problems are resolved or buildings are demolished.

Other important programs/activities completed by the housing inspection staff, include mobile home park inspections, fire damage assessment inspections, and Grants Management program inspections. Housing inspection staff have also assisted the Planning Division with zoning enforcement activities.

SUBJECT: 2013 U of I Certified Housing Summary

The initial inspection cycle began on September 9, 2013 and concluded on October 9, 2013, with 24 buildings inspected at 22 facilities. There were a total of 1,321 residents in Certified Housing for the 2013/2014 academic year, a decrease of 5 residents from last year. Nineteen of the buildings were cleared of all violations within the initial timelines, two in 53 days or less and one in 78 days. Two facilities were provided extensions for maintenance work and corrected during the December holiday break.

The majority of violations continue to be ongoing maintenance or average "wear and tear" issues as has been the case in past years. There were 43 smoke alarms missing or inoperative in seven buildings, with 26 of those in one building. Six carbon monoxide detectors were missing or inoperative in five buildings. The smoke alarm and CO detector violations were all corrected within 48 hours.

The use of improper extension cords, being found in 11 buildings as opposed to 10 last year continues to be an issue. We would recommend that systems requiring annual inspections (fire alarms, sprinklers and fire extinguishers) have automatic test renewals established with inspection providers to avoid expiration.

The number of properties that had no violations was four this year. They were:

710 W. Ohio, Delta Zeta	1104 W. Nevada, Sigma Delta Tau
703 S. Coler, Brown House	1110 W. Nevada, Gamma Phi Beta

All buildings required to be protected with the Code mandated fire sprinkler systems are so protected. There are two buildings without the systems which do not fall into the category requiring sprinkler systems.

Six of the houses were recognized for having individual rooms exceeding the University of Illinois' housekeeping standards. These are rooms that are extremely well kept.






