FRASCA INTERNATIONAL

Frasca International, Inc. - located in north Urbana - has been awarded a contract from the US Navy to build ten on-ground helicopter flight simulation training devices. Frasca will serve as a subcontractor to FlightSafety (located in Colorado) for the \$73 million military contract, the largest contract received by Frasca to-date. Frasca will construct the devices over the next two years.



To-date, 45 projects, containing a total of 102 units, have applied to receive Think Urbana incentives.

Total Square Feet Added Year-to-Date All Project Types

A total of 134,610 square feet were added in Urbana from January through September 2018.

Although the total of square feet added in 2018 was higher than for the previous two years, year-to-date construction was lower than in 2015 primarily due to the construction of 901 Western Apartments in July 2015.




Single-Family and Duplex Residential Square Feet Added

A total of 106,130 single-family and duplex new construction square feet were added year-to-date for new construction of one and two family homes from January through September of 2018 in Urbana, significantly higher than the prior three years.


Flash Index

The Flash Index continued to increase, raising from 105.1 in August to 105.2 in September, the highest it has been since May 2016.

2016 - 2018 Illinois Flash Index




