## 2020 Urbana Sweetcorn Festival Final Report

The 2020 Urbana Sweetcorn Festival was offered as the Sweetcorn Drive Thru on Friday, August 21, and the Virtual Sweetcorn Festival – *Remembering the Sweet Times* via Facebook on Saturday, August 22. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic we were forced to alter the festival as it has been offered in the past. However, we are very pleased with this year's offering and we can officially say that the Urbana Sweetcorn Festival went international for the first time. This year we partnered with Lincoln Square Mall to host the drive thru and University of Illinois Sousa Archives and Center for American Music – One Community Together Program to create the virtual lineup of entertainment.

The Sweetcorn Drive Thru was well attended of over 300 vehicles driving through to make sweetcorn, reusable commemorative tote, and PPE mask purchases. This gave customers an opportunity to purchase sweetcorn and cook it themselves at home to their personal liking and enjoy the virtual offerings the next day. The Virtual Sweetcorn Festival was offered via Facebook from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. It covered a plethora of genres of past performances from the last five years covering rock, 90's pop, county, swing, jazz, blues, gospel, DJs, and high school marching bands; there was definitely something for everyone! It also included a cooking demonstration, highlighting of downtown businesses and many children education activities provided by our local museums.

All of this would not have been possible without the Arts and Culture Grant Funding. Although faced with a pandemic we were still excited to be able to offer the wonderful community of Urbana an experience that we hope allowed them to reflect and remember the sweet times before with the thought that things will get better.

"Meet the Turtles at Homer Lake Forest Preserve" AND "Nature Investigation." Two engaging interactive videos about exploring nature and meeting the turtles that inhabit Central Illinois' prairies and forests presented by the staff of the Homer Lake Interpretive Center at the Champaign County Forest Preserve District.

"Creature Teachers - From the Parks to Your Backyard!" A short video presented by the staff of the Anita Purves Nature Center that asks, "If animals were your teachers, what would they tell you about life outdoors?"

"Conversations with Buffy the Bumble Bee." A colorful video about the lives of bumblebees on the Illinois prairie and a hands-on demonstration on how to create your own Buffy the Bumblebee from simple household materials presented by the staff of the University of Illinois' Pollinatarium.

"Baseball Rockets and Gravity Wells." An entertaining video demonstration targeted to children and their space-inquiring parents that explains how fast a baseball could travel through space toward the sun presented by the staff of Parkland College's Staerkel Planetarium.

"Drop spindles, Whirli-gigs, and Thaumatropes: Toys and Games of the Prairie." A humorous video demonstration of the toys and games played by central Illinois' children during the 19<sup>th</sup> century presented by the staff of the Museum of the Grand Prairie.

"Story Time for All Ages with Miss Kim." Four very special video sessions of stories told around the world presented by Kim Sheahan of the University of Illinois' Spurlock Museum.

"Silly-Dilly Inventions." A humorous video session for children of all ages that highlights some of the unusual inventions that changed people's lives in unexpected ways throughout the twentieth century presented by the staff of the University of Illinois' Distributed Museum.

"Three-nozzle Bloozer Horns and Other Instruments of the Band." A silly video for children on the instruments of the marching band and other crazy music instruments that can be built with found in your kitchen or garden shed presented by the staff of the University of Illinois' Sousa Archives and Center for American Music and members of the Marching Illini.
