Geothermal Urbana-Champaign

The geothermal bulk purchase program has started its third round with dates posted at geothermaluc.org.

Solar Urbana-Champaign

The solar bulk purchase program will start an eighth round in the coming months.

<u>Ucycle</u>

The City of Urbana will collaborate with Champaign County, the City of Champaign and the Village of Savoy to conduct two Spring events – a household hazardous waste collection event on April 15, and an electronics recycling collection event on May 20. The household hazardous waste event will be held at the State Farm Center in Champaign. Registration is required. Acceptable items include pesticides, herbicides, motor oil, gasoline, mercury containing devices, oil-based paints, and more! The electronics recycling collection event in May will be held at Parkland College in Champaign (registration required starting on April 17). Electronic devices such as televisions, computers/laptops, mobile phones, stereo equipment, VCRS/DVD players, and more will be accepted. More information can be found online at ecycle.simplybook.me.
