## **Updates**

#### 25 O'CLOCK BREWERY

25 O'Clock Brewery is now serving beer on their patio located at 208 W Griggs St. Patrons to the new brewery can look out onto the Boneyard Creek Crossing while enjoying a beer, or fill growlers to go. Renovations for the tap room and Pizza M spaces are ongoing.

#### 208 W MAIN ST

The renovation and opening of Cafeteria & Company has completed at 208 W Main St in Downtown Urbana. The cafe will serve coffee and sandwiches including nitro coffee. See You CD & Vinyl will relocate from their current location at 123 W Main St to the back area of 208 W Main St on May 4th. In the new location, See you CD & Vinyl will expand their collection and have drinks available.

#### URBANA AT GEN CON

Two local Urbana businesses will hold events at the 2018 Indianapolis Gen Con, the largest tabletop-game convention in North America. Founded in 1968, Gen Con is a four day convention for all types of hobby gaming. Over the past four years the event has grown in attendance, to a total of over 60,000 people in 2017. CU Adventures will return to the Indianapolis Gen Con for the second year. In 2017 they sold out over 100 escape room sessions with eight available slots each. The Champaign-Urbana Design Organization, located in [co][lab] will also present a seminar at Gen Con on creating a board game design community.

#### **BUSINESS OUTREACH**

In April, Economic Development staff spoke with eight potential developers, and an additional 11 potential new and expanding businesses. Staff attended nine networking and training events including an International Council of Shopping Centers lunch, the Illinois Tax Increment Financing Association Spring Conference, and Urbana Business Association and Young Professionals of Champaign Urbana networking events.

#### THINK URBANA MARKETING

A targeted Facebook marketing campaign for Think Urbana began in March and will continue through June 2018, featuring a new testimonial video. The City and Urbana Business Association held the first Neighborhood Realtor Tour on March 19th, the second Realtor tour will be held on May 10th at Stone Creek. #### STONE CREEK GOLF COURSE

The Atkins Group (TAG) is currently exploring options for the future of the Stone Creek Golf Course. TAG has committed to operating the golf course through 2018 and is keeping homeowners informed in the process.

#### STANGO CUISINE

Stango Cuisine completed their renovation of the Lincoln Square food court area. The restaurant will serve lunch and early dinner Tuesday through Saturday, offering Zambian cuisine. Stango Cuisine will donate 10% of all sales to the One Dream Foundation to assist with construction of a hospital in Zambia.



# **Total Square Feet Added Year**to-Date All Project Types

A total of 73,469 square feet were added in Urbana from January through April 2018. This growth was higher than the past three years for these months. This increase is largely due to eight new single family homes with permits pulled in April.

# Single-Family and Duplex Residential Square Feet Added


A total of 60,217 square feet were added year-to-date for new construction one and two family homes from January through April of 2018 in Urbana. This amount was significantly higher than the prior three years.

# Year-To-Date Square Footage Added


All New Construction & Additions

Single and Two Family New Construction



### Home Sales

March 2018 home sales were 2.36% lower than in March 2017, with 207 closed sales compared to 212. April 2018 home sales are expected to increase over homes sold in April 2017.
