



Community Development Commission – 1 VACANCY

The Community Development Commission shall consist of 9 members serving 3-year terms.

Qualifications:

The Community Development Commission shall include:

- residents of the Community Development Target Area (the area of the city designated by City Council to receive Federal Community Development Block Grant funds)
- residents with professional backgrounds related to community development
- residents interested in the community development programs

There shall be no requirement that the Commission be balanced with an equal number of residents from the Target Area, residents from professional backgrounds, and residents generally interested in community development.

Purpose:

The purpose of the Community Development Commission is to advise the Mayor and City Council on community development goals, objectives, and resource allocations; monitor, evaluate, and recommend community development activities; seek out and receive community input; and represent the population in community development activities. With assistance from the staff of the Grants Management Division, the Commission shall also develop and recommend to the Urbana City Council a community development plan from time to time, or other related documents, consistent with the requirements of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
