- The Urbana Fire Department is an ISO Class I rated Fire Service
- We are 59 Fire Fighters that provide:
  - Fire Suppression
  - Fire Prevention
  - EMT – Intermediate Level service to our community (18 Paramedics, 18 Intermediates and 23 Basic EMT providers)
  - MABAS Division 28 Technical Rescue Response Team
  - Hazardous Materials Operations Response Team
  - 8 Fully Trained Fire Investigators
  - Working together with the other City Departments to best serve our community

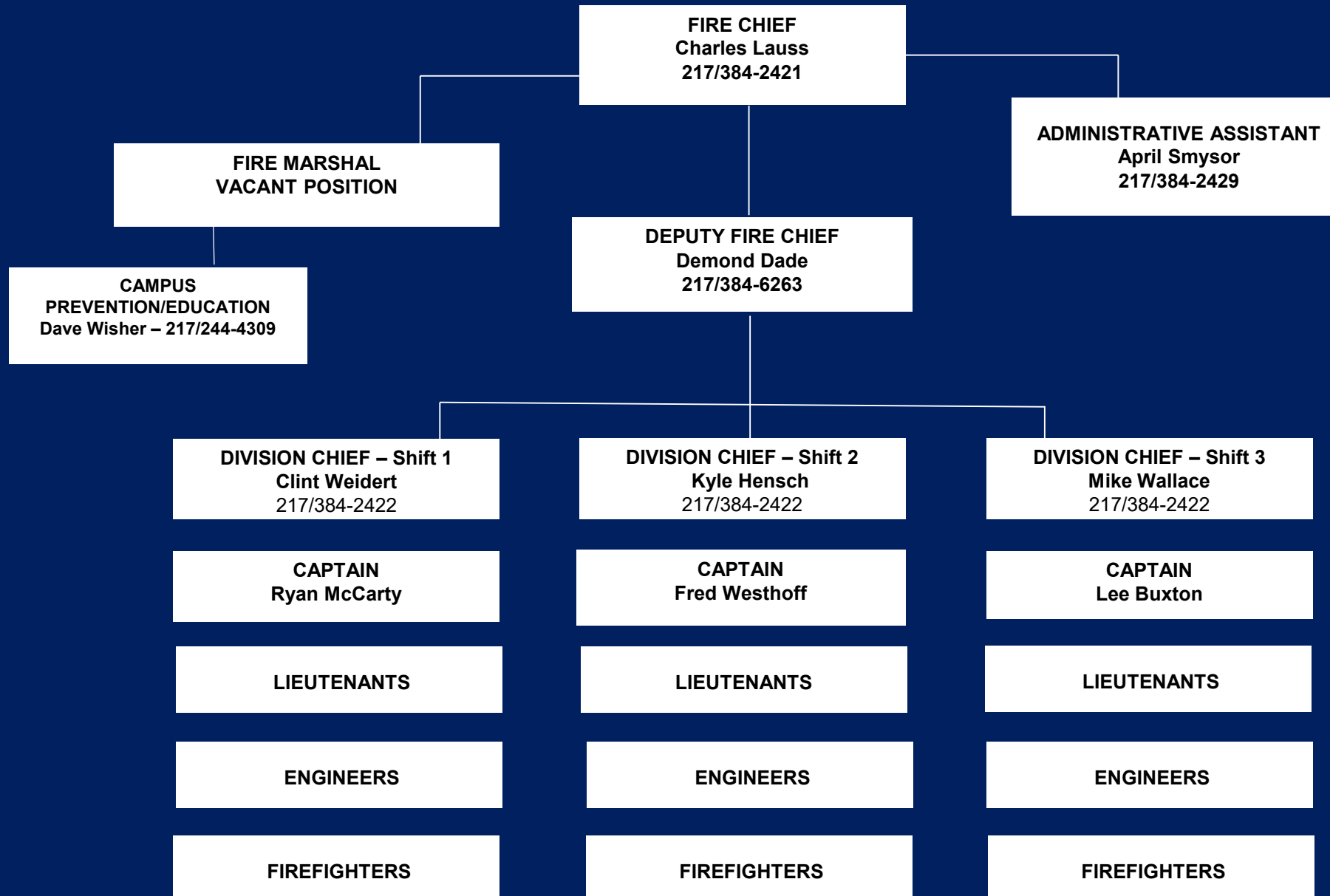
# COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING

- 53 Sworn Line Fire Fighters on 3 Shifts working 24 hours on and 48 hours off
- 4 Stations with 1 – Truck Company, 4 – Engine Companies and 1 – Command Car

- The Urbana Fire Department has 4 Stations strategically located within the City of Urbana. One of those stations is owned and maintained by the University of Illinois. We are located at:
  - 400 South Vine Street
  - Philo Road (South Fire Station)
  - Lincoln Avenue (North Fire Station)
  - Gregory Street (Campus Station)

# CENTRAL STATION 400 SOUTH VINE ST.



- Built and occupied in 1964
- Car 220 with the Battalion Chief
- Ladder Tower 261 with a Captain, Engineer and Fire Fighter
- Engine 251 with a Lieutenant, Engineer and Fire Fighter
- Administrative Offices

# SOUTH STATION (#2) 2103 S. PHILO ROAD



- Built and occupied est. late 1969
- Engine 252 with a Lieutenant, Engineer and Fire Fighter.
- This Station has been identified to be replaced in the Facility Master Plan



# NORTH STATION (#3) 1407 N. LINCOLN AVE.



- Built and occupied est. late 1970
- Engine 253 with a Lieutenant, Engineer and Fire Fighter
- This Station has also been identified to be replaced in the Facility Master Plan

# UNIVERSITY STATION (#4) | 105 W. GREGORY



- Built and occupied est. mid 2001
- Built after the University of Illinois Fire Department was merged with Urbana Fire and Champaign Fire Departments.
- Engine 254 with a Lieutenant, an Engineer and a Fire Fighter
- Car 212, the University of Illinois Fire Prevention Officer
