Do You Have Lights On Your Bicycle So You Can Ride At Night?

Illinois Rules of the Road requires that every bicycle, when in use at nighttime, must be equipped with a lamp on the front able to emit a white light visible from a distance of at least 500 feet AND a red reflector on the rear visible from 100-600 feet.

Come by with your bicycle during the annual "Light the Night" and we'll install a free front light, rear light and rear reflector on your bike while supplies last. Light sets will only be installed on bicycles without lights.
