Having trouble paying for power bills? Know someone behind on gas and electric? APPLY FOR LIHEAP utility assistance!

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) helps low income households with the cost of power bills.

Who can apply?

Households with income up to 150% of the federal poverty level can apply:

1	\$1,561
2	\$2,113
3	\$2,666
4	\$3,218
5	\$3,771

When can I apply?

- <u>Starting October 1</u> Seniors 60 years and older and people with disabilities can apply.
- <u>Starting November 1</u> Households with a child age 5 or under can apply. Also, households where power is disconnected or about to be disconnected can apply.
- <u>Starting December 1</u> All low-income households can apply.

Applications will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis through May 31, 2020, or until funding is gone.

How do I apply?

- You will be given an appointment

What should I bring to my appointment? (start gathering this now)

- Proof of <u>total</u> household income for the past 30 days (paystubs, etc)
- Social Security numbers for <u>all</u> household members
- Your most recent gas and electric bill within the last 30 days
- If you have a disconnection notice, bring that too
- People who are disabled will also need to show proof of disability
- Anything else requested of you
