Bridging the Blues \$2,000

All Score Urbana: Music & Dance \$1,975

## **Music Events & Workshops**

Urbana Pops Orchestra's 15th Concert Season \$4,300

Fiddle & Jam Weekend \$4,500

**Community Center for the Arts**

Rose Bowl After Market \$4,500

Unmute and Level Up: Sound Engineering Mini Course and Concert Series \$4,500

Creativity on Wheels \$4,999
