

In 2012, the Urbana Police Department created the Champaign County Crisis Intervention Team Steering Committee (CITSC). The committee is a collaboration of local mental health providers, the local hospitals, Champaign County States Attorney's Office, NAMI, Danville VA, the Champaign County Mental Health Board and several local law enforcement agencies.

In 2013 Champaign County law enforcement agencies adopted a unified CIT response policy. This policy guides all CIT officers within the county towards a standardized response and permits, when needed, utilization of a CIT officer from neighboring agencies. The monitoring of this policy and its effectiveness is tasked to the CITSC.
